Strawbery Banke to Date:

- Incorporated in 1958
- 37 historic structures
- 13 gardens
- Lawrence J. Yerdon Visitors Center opened in 2005 (expansion opened 2013); provides museum ticketing services and an orientation center for visitors.
- Carter Collection Center opened in 2007; dedicated to the storage and preservation of archaeological, photograph, manuscript and decorative arts collections.
- Labrie Family Skate at Puddle Dock Pond, seasonal outdoor ice rink, introduced 2014.
- Costumed roleplayers, crafts demonstrations, interactive site interpretations.
