Position Description:

The success of each of Strawberry Banke's special events depends on volunteers. Each event is slightly different and offers a variety of volunteer opportunities.

These include:

- Set up assistance
- Parking lot attendant
- Greeting
- Collateral distribution
- Assisting in youth programming
- Clean up
- And much more!

Qualifications:

Special events volunteers should be excited about the Museum and its mission, as well as good customer service skills. Volunteers should be able to sit or stand for long periods, and may be asked to lift relatively heavy objects if they are able. Special events take place primarily outdoors, so volunteers should plan and dress accordingly based on the weather.

Location:

- Volunteers meet with the Museum Events Manager prior to each event in a designated location. This location is emailed to volunteers within 48 hours of their volunteer shift.
