

# SITE RENTAL OPPORTUNITIES

Strawbery Banke Museum offers unique spaces and historical settings for a wide variety of special events from small private gatherings and meetings to weddings and large corporate functions.



## PUDDLE DOCK

*Puddle Dock was once a large tidal inlet that allowed ships to dock right beside buildings at high tide. Today, Puddle Dock is an expansive lawn within the Museum grounds.*

Accommodates tents up to 210' x 50' and up to 3,000 guests for large weddings, parties, corporate and social events.



## GOODWIN GARDEN

*Goodwin Garden is a lovely Victorian garden composed largely of bedding annuals – an example of a mid-to late 19th century landscape.*

Accommodates tents up to 30' x 40' and up to 120 guests for intimate gatherings and wedding receptions.



## THOMAS BAILEY ALDRICH MEMORIAL GARDEN

*Aldrich Garden is our most intimate space with perennial plantings, a hemlock grove, reproduction garden furnishings and brick pathways.*

Accommodates 10' x 10' tents and up to 50 guests for intimate gatherings and wedding receptions.





## TYCO VISITOR CENTER

*The Tyco Visitors Center is styled after the many warehouse structures that once populated the Portsmouth waterfront and offers modern conveniences including a media room, lecture hall, and café.*

Accommodates up to 90 guests for a cocktail style reception or lecture, and 70 guests for a seated dinner.

Amenities include restrooms and kitchenette.



## PITT TAVERN

*Built in 1766, historic Pitt Tavern was an important gathering place for local citizenry during the critical years of the Revolution.*

Accommodates up to 50 people (in separate rooms) for receptions, small dinners, birthday parties, and breakout groups.

Amenities include restrooms and small service kitchen.



## STOODLEY'S TAVERN EDUCATION CENTER

*Home to the family of James Stoodley, who served in the French and Indian War, the Tavern was a popular community gathering place in the 1760s.*

Accommodates groups of 5 to 45 (in various rooms) for meetings, presentations, retreats and small gatherings.

Amenities include restrooms and some kitchen facilities.
