To our valued visitors:

Thank you for your interest in visiting Strawberry Banke Museum.

Through more than three centuries of war, disease, strife and disruption to their daily lives, the families who lived in the houses at Puddle Dock ultimately supported each other. They looked out for their neighbors. In that same spirit, Strawberry Banke Museum continues to take pandemic safety measures very seriously.

All visitors to Strawberry Banke, regardless of vaccination status, are required to wear a mask over the mouth and nose in all indoor spaces, and outside when physical distancing of six feet (6') is difficult to maintain between people from different households.

Strawbery Banke has made the decision as a private museum to continue universal masking for the immediate future.

This policy is in compliance with the Safer at Home Universal Best Practices from the State of New Hampshire Governor's Economic Task Force as well as the City of Portsmouth's Mask Mandate, which is in effect through June 30, 2021.

This policy is for everyone's health and safety. If you feel uncomfortable with this policy, we understand and urge you to return at a time when this public health crisis is genuinely behind us.
